Homework Changes for 2026-27: Information Evening for Parents and Carers

We are excited to inform you that we are making some changes to our approach to homework for September 2026, for years 7-11. We warmly invite all families to an information evening about this on **Wednesday 15th July, 5-5.45pm** in the main hall. We will explain the main changes and be available to answer any questions you might have. Refreshments will be provided.

A summary of our approach to homework is as follows:

- **Sparx Maths, Reader and Science will continue for all year groups.**
- **Students will also complete daily 30 minute homeworks on core curriculum knowledge. This is called self-quizzing.**
- **Year 11 will also have additional written homework for each subject, as was set out at the Year 10 information evening a few weeks ago.**

During the information evening we will share with you:

- what self-quizzing is
- why self-quizzing is so effective and so important for students' progress
- how self-quizzing will work logistically
- how to self-quiz effectively
- how we will support students at school
- how you can support students at home

We look forward to seeing you all on the 15th July.
