Results Day and Sixth Form Induction

This letter contains important information for all students about Results Day. It also contains important information for any students who have applied to our sixth form.

Results Day:

GCSE Results Day is on Thursday 20th August 2026. It is essential that all students attend results day for the following reasons:

1. It is important students find out their grades, so that they can make an informed decision about where they study in September
2. Students will need to enrol on sixth form and college courses; for some courses early enrolment is important where numbers are limited and coming into school is the quickest way to find out results. For students attending our sixth form we will confirm their courses in person on results day.
3. Students will each have a 1-1 appointment with a member of the senior team. During this appointment we will be able to provide expert guidance to students, whether that's because they've achieved higher grades or lower grades than they thought.
4. As a school we are legally obliged to record all students' destination data.
5. Results Day is an important rite of passage for students! It's the final time we come together as a year group and a great chance to celebrate together.

The school will be open from 9-11am for results. Parents and carers are welcome to attend with their children. If you know you are not able to attend in person, please could you complete this [form](#). Your child's GCSE certificates will be posted to you.

If you are an external applicant we would like you to attend the school on Thursday 20th August between 11am and 1 pm. This will give you the opportunity to go and collect results from your home school. If you are an external student and you are based some distance away, please email cnijhawan@hartlandhigh.co.uk following results day and we will be able to support with the final confirmation of your place and your courses.

Sixth Form Dress Code:

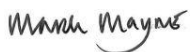
