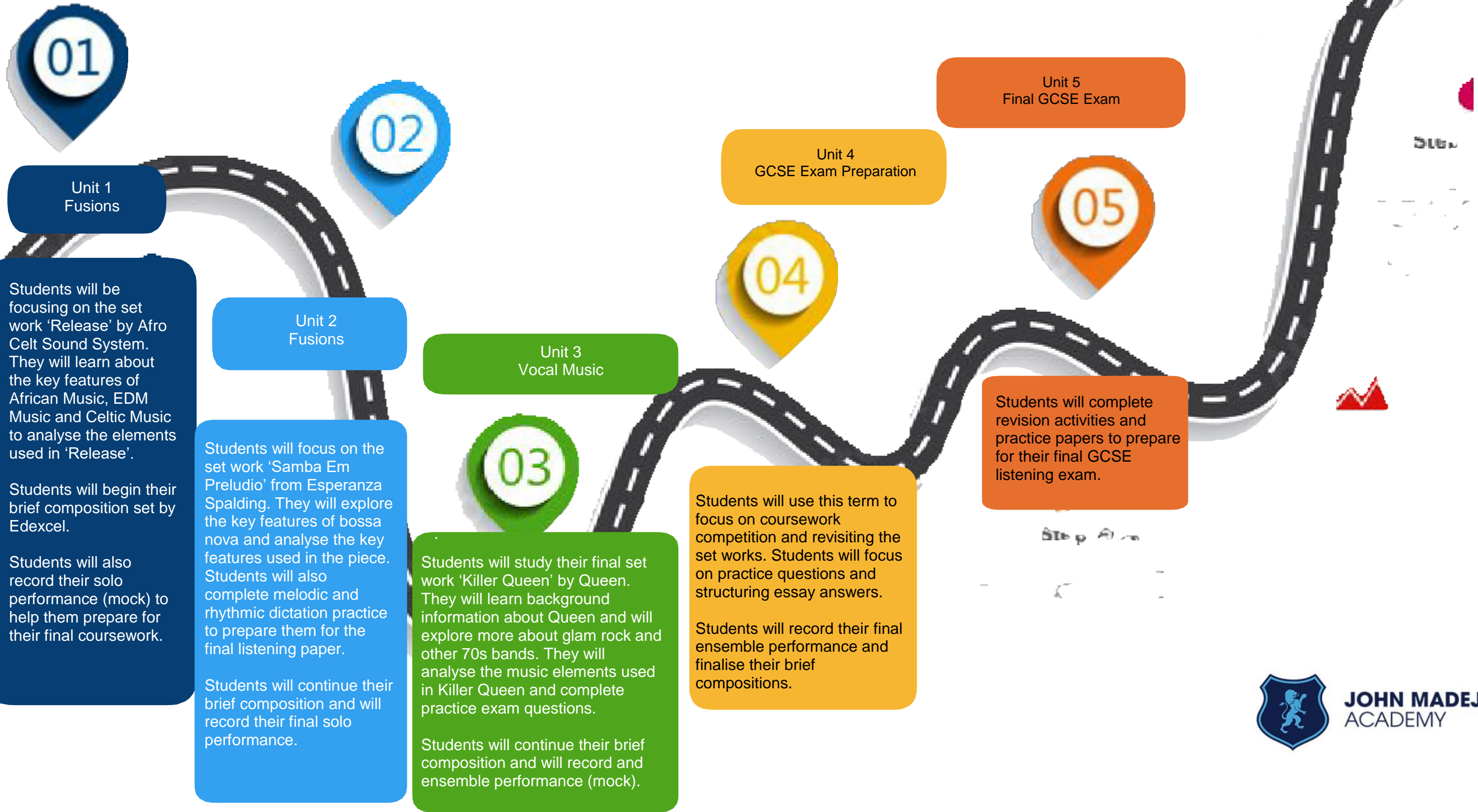


Year 11 GCSE Music Curriculum Road Map

Unit 1
Fusions

Students will be focusing on the set work 'Release' by Afro Celt Sound System. They will learn about the key features of African Music, EDM Music and Celtic Music to analyse the elements used in 'Release'.

Students will begin their brief composition set by Edexcel.

Students will also record their solo performance (mock) to help them prepare for their final coursework.

Unit 2
Fusions

Students will focus on the set work 'Samba Em Preludio' from Esperanza Spalding. They will explore the key features of bossa nova and analyse the key features used in the piece. Students will also complete melodic and rhythmic dictation practice to prepare them for the final listening paper.

Students will continue their brief composition and will record their final solo performance.

Unit 3
Vocal Music

Students will study their final set work 'Killer Queen' by Queen. They will learn background information about Queen and will explore more about glam rock and other 70s bands. They will analyse the music elements used in Killer Queen and complete practice exam questions.

Students will continue their brief composition and will record and ensemble performance (mock).
