Unit 3 – What is truth?

Understanding how we come to a knowledge of “Truth”

Core skills and knowledge: knowledge of the role and limitations of holy books, logic, experience, history and science in the pursuit of truth.

Unit 1 – What is the religious imagination?

Understanding how different religions answer some of our basic questions

Core skills and knowledge: reading, understanding of location, size and core beliefs of main world faiths.

Unit 4 – What are the “Western” religions?

Understanding the roots of Judaism, Christianity and Islam

Core skills and knowledge: knowledge of five key religious figures, understanding and evaluating their legacy and what it means for religious believers

Unit 2 – What does a religious way of life look like?

Understanding what some of the main religious practices are in the main world faiths.

Core skills and knowledge: reading of different text types, analysis of practices, comparing religions.
